4-H members and leaders must enroll each 4-H year (October 1-September 30). To enroll as a *new member or new leader*, complete the Leader/Member Enrollment Form. Be sure that all the information is complete and correct. It is especially important for members to complete their birthday and grade. If a member or leader needs special accommodation, please call WSU Extension King County at (206) 205-3100.

The program fee (\$6.00 per 4-H member, \$7.00 per horse 4-H member and \$5.00 per 4-H leader) may be included with your enrollment by return mail. Checks should be made payable to King County 4-H Association. Scholarship funds are available for members in need. For requests, call Floy Ziegler at (206) 723-2607. All program fees are used by the King County 4-H Association for general operating expenses, including the purchase of member medical insurance, ribbons, pins, leader education, and activity scholarships for leaders and members.

As a participant in the 4-H Program your son/daughter may be asked to help with the evaluation of the program. At the end of each program or program year, we conduct an evaluation to tell us how well the program is working. Your son/daughter may be asked to complete a written survey about what he/she may have learned from participating in the program. We estimate that it will take the youth participants approximately 10 minutes to complete the survey. Youth are not required to participate in the evaluation. If your son/daughter decides that they do not wish to participate, it will not affect their participation in this or future WSU Extension programs. If your son/daughter does not want to answer some questions on the survey, that is okay. The survey responses will be anonymous, and your son's/daughter's responses will not be identified in any way. If you do not want your son/daughter to participate in the evaluation of 4-H, please contact Carris Booker at (206) 205-3177 before your child begins attending the program.
