ALL GDB YOUTH RAISERS AND YOUTH PUPPY SITTERS ARE ELIGIBLE TO SHOW

Registration and Vet Check: 8:00 AM-8:30 AM Decorations will be provided and set up prior to your arrival. Please bring your tie down, non-slippery rug for your pup and club banner (optional).

Guide Dog Bowl: 9:00 AM Seniors start at 9:00 AM . Seniors will compete against each other. Intermediates will follow when seniors finish. Juniors will follow Intermediates. Ribbons will be awarded to each age division.

Guide Dog Control Class: 11:00 AM

- Puppies 13 months & older**
- Puppies 10-12 months**
- Puppies 7-9 months**
- Puppies 4-6 months**

Control class will consist of obedience performance in and around obstacles and distractions. Recall on Leash will be performed as a food reward recall. Long sits and downs will be performed as a group. Participation ribbons plus Champion and Reserve Champion Ribbons will be awarded for each puppy division.

Evaluation will go on throughout the day

Evaluation will consist of a walk around the fair grounds with two evaluators. This event is to evaluate how your puppy reacts to various situations. If the puppy has more than one raiser the raisers will trade handling half way through the evaluation course.

Fitting and Showing: 2:00 PM

- Juniors** (3rd, 4th, 5th grade 2006-2007 school year)
- Intermediate** (6th, 7th, 8th grade 2006-2007 year)
- Senior** (9th, 10th, 11th, 12th grade 2006-2007 year)

Fitting and Showing will consist of demonstrating puppy handling skills, ring showmanship, pattern work and 3 questions. Show attire is formal and must meet 4-H dress code and be appropriate for exhibiting in front of the public. Participation ribbons plus Champion and Reserve Champion Ribbons will be awarded for each age division.

Costume Class: 5:00 PM **Youth** (Junior, Intermediate, senior)

Herdsmanship: Herdsmanship will be judged 4 times during the day. There must be one 4-Her on duty per 3 dogs plus one adult per club.

Awards Ceremony: 6:00 PM Ribbons will be presented for all classes at this time.

Clean up: 8:00 PM All participants will be dismissed after the barn is clean.

ALL 4-H PUPS ARE REQUIRED TO STAY FROM 9:00AM UNTIL 8:00 PM. **Adult and Non 4-H pups may arrive and leave throughout the day.**
